Grout looks patchy after cleaning.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incomplete rinsing. • Grout not completely dry. • Could be permanent discoloration exposed after cleaning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse with clean water. • Allow to dry. • For repair of permanently discolored grout apply Aqua Mix Grout Colorant.
Residue on surface after cleaning (Most likely a white crystalline residue).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cleaner not completely removed after cleaning or lack of proper rinsing. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse surface several times with clean water and use Aqua Mix NanoScrub and white pad.
Is not effectively cleaning, stripping the floor finish or wax.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The cleaner may need to be used neat or allowed to dwell longer on the surface. • The material you are trying to strip is not a floor finish or wax. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the material you are trying to strip is not a wax or floor finish strip using Aqua Mix Sealer and Coating Remover.
